

Dr Margarita Arianoutsou – Farangitaki

Margarita Arianoutsou is an Associate Professor of Ecology in the Department of Ecology and Systematics at the Faculty of Biology of National and Kapodistrian University of Athens. She has a considerable experience in the research field of *Ecology and Management of Mediterranean ecosystems* in which she is actively engaged for the last 25 years. She has been elected and acted twice as the Secretary of the International Society of Mediterranean Ecologists (*ISOMED*) for the years 1987-1991 and from 2000 onwards. She has been a member of the working group established to support the Hellenic National Committee for the Implementation of *UN Convention to Combat Desertification*. Among other activities and commitments, she is a member of the Scientific Committee of the *European Centre of Forest Fires*. During the period 2002-2005 she has offered as the Secretary of the Board of Directors for the management of Mt. Parnes National Park. She has participated in more than 50 International Symposia - Conferences. She has published more than 60 scientific articles and she has edited 4 books published by (Dr Junk) Kluwer, Plenum Press and Millpress. She has supervised 10 Ph. D theses and more than 20 First Diploma Theses. She is actively involved in Environmental Education and Awareness Campaigns, for which she has also published a book.
