Simon Reddy is the manager of the C40 Climate Leadership Group (C40) secretariat and responsible for co-ordinating and communicating the work of the C40 cities. The C40 is a group of the world's largest cities committed to tackling climate change. The C40 secretariat is based in the Mayor of London's offices at City hall in London.

Prior to taking this position in March 2007, Simon worked for Greenpeace UK and Greenpeace International since 1992, most recently as Director of Policy and Solutions for Greenpeace UK.

Simon was responsible for setting up a solutions department within Greenpeace UK and led and co-ordinated work on 'decentralised energy'. He also led Greenpeace's work with the Mayor of London and the GLA on various 'Decentralised Energy' reports and the Gallions Park zero carbon development.

Over a 15year period at Greenpeace, Simon has also worked as a political adviser on ocean issues representing Greenpeace at various international political fora, a campaigner working on oil and gas issues and platform dumping and as a deckhand on Greenpeace ships.
