

Prof. Arthouros Zervos has received his BSE and MSE degrees from the Mechanical and Aerospace Engineering Department of Princeton University, U.S.A. and his Doctorate degree from the University Paris VI in France. He is a Faculty Member at the Mechanical Engineering Department of the National Technical University of Athens since 1982.

Professor Arthouros Zervos has more than two decades of high-level expertise in policy, science, research and technology across the European renewable energy sector. He has led the key European renewable energy bodies. He has acted as policy advisor to Governments, EU bodies and policy fora.
